POLICY DIRECTIVE

To clarify where responsibilities for construction of the above entranceways lie.

HISTORY

P O L I C Y

1. Any ratepayer requesting Council to construct or repair an entranceway between the road pavement and the property boundary, will be advised that this work may be carried out by the Council at his/her cost, or alternatively by a contractor or him/herself subject to approval by the Director of Works & Engineering Services under the supervision of his Department.
2. Where Council's activities, such as an open drain, necessitate a pipe being laid in an entranceway, Council will carry out this work at its own expense.
3. Where Council roadworks and other activities cause damage to entranceways, Council repair same at its own expense.
4. All entranceways are to be constructed in accordance with Council's specifications and to a standard satisfactory to the Director of Works & Engineering Services.
