POLICY

This policy applies to the management of residential mobile garbage bins and does not include commercial garbage bins:

1. Council will provide one 240 litre mobile garbage bin to new residential dwellings at no charge.
2. Once a bin has been provided it is the responsibility of the ratepayer to maintain their mobile garbage bins to a functional standard.
3. Additional bins, replacement bins or parts for maintenance can be purchased as per the fees & charges schedule.
4. The ratepayer may nominate to have more than 1 mobile garbage bin collected per property. Each additional bin will be rated at the standard waste management rate.
5. It is the responsibility of the occupier to keep their mobile garbage bins clean and tidy through regular cleaning and proper care.
6. Council will only collect waste that:
 - Rates have been paid for.
 - Contained wholly within the garbage bin. Excess waste beside the bin will not be collected.
 - Does not contain commercial or non-conforming waste streams for kerbside collection.
 - The bin has functional wheels and lid.
 - Is placed at or near the kerb/roadside with the handle facing the road for collection.
