## **POLICY**

- (i) The director of Works and Engineering Services has authority to require landholders to remove trees where such trees threaten to fall on roads and could be a traffic hazard or danger to pedestrians – after consultation with the General Manager. All work associated with the removal of such trees shall be at the landholder's expense.
- (ii) The Director of Works and Engineering Services has authority to remove trees from roadways where it is necessary to do so to facilitate roadworks. (It would, however, be prudent for the Director of Works and Engineering Services to confer with landholders, prior to the taking of this action).
- (iii) Fallen trees or limbs that are a traffic hazard or a danger to the public on public road will be removed by Council's staff and costs associated with this function, where possible, funded from allocations which may be set aside for this purpose.
